APPLICATION GUIDANCE

Your application should include a full CV, and a research proposal for the initial five year period of the position. Please submit the completed application in pdf format to enquiries@slcu.cam.ac.uk

FULL CV

Please include the following information:

- Personal details:
 - Full name, including title
 - Address for correspondence
 - E-mail address
 - Contact telephone number including country code
 - Nationalities
 - Whether or not you require a visa to work in the UK
- Career summary to date:
 - Current position, including job title, current department, full organisation name, source of funding, start date and contracted end date (if permanent, state 'permanent')
 - A full list of peer reviewed publications and papers in press. Where appropriate, include the URL. Draft or submitted publications should not be included
 - Successful grant applications to date, including dates, amounts and awarding bodies. For currently active grants, indicate whether these would continue if you were to become a Group Leader in the Sainsbury Laboratory
 - Details of pending grant applications, including dates, amounts applied for, and awarding bodies. Include the expected date when the outcome will be known in each case
 - Career history. Include your PhD title, year of award and awarding institution

RESEARCH PROPOSAL

Describe your proposed research over the initial five year period as Group Leader. Include the following:

- An outline of your proposed research, including a one paragraph summary suitable for the general public. The proposal and public summary should be no more than 4 pages of A4 at 10 point text, including the reference list, figures etc.
- An illustrative diagram or table, for example a GANTT chart, with indicative timescales for the individual components of the proposal. The chart is not included in the 4 page limit.
- Any major infrastructure or equipment necessary for the proposed research

You should also indicate the date you are likely to be available to take up employment in Cambridge.

REFERENCES

Please provide full contact details including e-mail addresses for a minimum of three referees. At least one referee should be external to your current research institution.
